# NPS Education Program

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- ① NPS has a well-developed elementary program
- ② Refine for the Lincoln-Eliot community
- ③ NECP education program documented
- ④ Educational program addresses current and future needs
- ⑤ Education planning/visioning sessions with Lincoln-Eliot and NECP principals and staff on October 17<sup>th</sup> and October 19<sup>th</sup>
- ⑥ Consultant team to provide feedback and expertise to **finalize** the education programs

# Ed Program Planning – L-EES

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- Continued development of the NPS Elementary Model
  - What is the latitude for innovation?
- Incorporating future teaching modalities will depend upon having spaces that can be used in more than one way
- Special Education Program Review
  - Needs to be defined



# Ed Program Planning – NECP

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- Evolution of the Early Childhood Model
- Integrated model vs. Inclusion model
  - Brookline, Wellesley, Newton Models reviewed
  - Project team to review other schematics (Dedham, future Wellesley, Chelsea, Cambridge)
- Space to accommodate future growth and more extended day services
  - Extended day services planned as inclusive
